


Private Spaces at Salem State University

As a public university, members of the public outside of the Salem State University community are welcome to visit and attend most events and athletic games. However, there are spaces on campus that are considered private and not open to the public; namely, those spaces where students and employees have a reasonable expectation of privacy. The list below delineates which spaces on campus have been deemed private and, thus, not accessible to the general public or external law enforcement without a signed judicial warrant.
