The Northeast contains all of Essex County and nine communities (Bedford, Billerica, Chelmsford, Dracut, Dunstable, Lowell, Tewksbury, Tyngsborough, and Westford) from the northern portion of Middlesex County. UMass-Lowell, Salem State College and Middlesex, North Shore, and Northern Essex Community Colleges are located in this region.


## Greater Boston Region:

All of Suffolk, a majority of Middlesex and Norfolk, and communities from the eastern edge of Worcester and northern edge of Plymouth Counties make up Greater Boston.
