How do I access the online catalogue?

1. In your preferred web browser, visit [www. www.salem.bkstr.com](http://www.salem.bkstr.com).
2. Scroll to the bottom, and click on the "Custom Gifts" link under "Faculty Services"
3. Click the link "Simply click here to get started"
4. The next page will prompt you for a password, it is "bookstore"
5. Use the links on the left or the search function to browse the catalog
6. When you click on an item it will show you the minimum order quantities, lead time, and any optional services.

How do I place an order?
